ASSIGNMENTS

If your child is registered for Foundations or Honors Art, they will be expected to complete a weekly sketchbook assignment. For those building a portfolio, additional individual projects may be suggested to achieve the student's goals.

THE EXPERIENCE

Honors Art is an ongoing, progressive fine art curriculum great for those seeking a formal, yet experimental experience in drawing and painting technique. Our classes are designed to build upon previous lessons, just like in a traditional classroom environment. So, sticking around for awhile will allow your student to have the most growth.

As the student's skills develop, they will be coached along independently to continue their progression under our mentorship. They will be free to experiment, think, and even fail (because that is when we find happy mistakes and learn to keep going!)

Students will **not** hear, "Today we will paint this apple." Instead, they will learn a technique, then apply what they learn to a project they find intriguing, and a composition appropriate for their level of skill at that time. This is how we inspire those who are just beginning, and those who may have had some prior experience and ensure growth in each student.
